<u>Fall Tour</u>: October 23, 2022. We plan to make a back roads run up to Hartford, Wisconsin, leaving from the vicinity of Deer Park, Illinois. Hartford is home to the Wisconsin Automotive museum which displays a large collection Kissel automobiles and other cars manufactured in Wisconsin. We would likely meet about 9:00 with a departure time around 10:00 am. We will extend the invitation to the Lotus and Streeters Clubs.
